This was a ruling emphasized  
yesterday by Chief of Police  
August Kretzman who added that  
there was no any complaint or  
unhappily motorists will be  
harmed.

Durham Ordway, officer who  
has been riding around on the  
school bus, said that his inspec-  
tion now is to issue citations be-  
cause of the law.

There hasn't been an accident  
involving a school child, he  
said Chief Kretzman, "and we  
are not making to do anything  
but observe."

The police had further pointed  
out that the situation here could  
be bad if extra precautions were  
not observed.

"Many of the places where the  
bus stops," continued Chief Kret-  
zman, "are in residential areas  
and children either board or dis-  
embar from the bus directly  
onto the street."
