Thousand Palms Gravel Plant Is OK'd By Planners

Plans for an asphalt plant, rock crusher and sand and gravel pit in the Thousand Palms area won approval of the County Planning Commission last week.

At the close of discussions leading to endorsement of the industrial project the commissioners were warned by Atty. Enos Reid, spokesman of opponents of the enterprise, that it will be vigorously opposed before the County Board of Supervisors.

A public hearing on the plant proposal will be set by the supervisors when the application is forwarded by the planners.

Reid declared that a number of property owners of the Thousand Palms area will be united in fighting the project on the grounds that it would be detrimental to residential and recreational values of the community.
